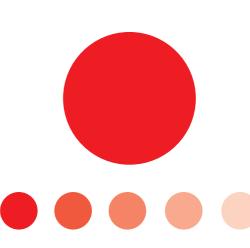

## **Secondary Color**

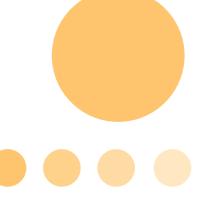

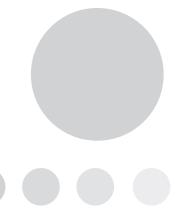
